The national PTA office will send a customized certificate, suitable for framing, that recognizes your PTA for its efforts.

To qualify, your PTA must meet all four of the following requirements:

- ◆ Obtained a 5 percent net increase in membership or a minimum of one member per student in the unit's school(s).
- ◆ Conducted at least one program or project that provided an opportunity for parents to be involved in the school. (Post your program ideas on the PTA Great Idea Bank at www.pta.org/greatideabank.)
- ◆ Conducted at least one program or project that increased awareness among parents about issues that affect student achievement or school success. (Post your program ideas on the PTA Great Idea Bank at www.pta.org/greatideabank.)
- ◆ The unit participated in the state PTA's convention or another state-sponsored event.
