



Create Your Own Family Education Plan Work Sheet #2

A Family Education Plan (FEP) helps parents and families identify specific projects, programs, practices and activities that can build and enrich the learning climate in their home and enhance a child's education. An FEP helps families to identify their values and needs. An FEP connects home to school and school to home and empowers the children to succeed.

FEP Mission Statement: What is the purpose of our family and education?

Write a statement describing your family, its purpose, vision, and goal for life-long learning. (i.e. "The Jones family reads together 20 minutes every day" or "Every member of our family will be loved and supported to reach his or her full potential"). Display your Family Mission Statement in a prominent place. Small cards prepared for each family member to keep in their wallet build and nourishes family unity.

What are our Family Values, important Character Traits and Citizenships?

Name and describe some values and character traits that are important and honored in your family. (work ethic, sense of responsibility, honesty, fairness, cooperation, dependability, respect, etc.) How can you tell a good citizen? What can our family do to be more loyal to our country and active in our community?

Family Educational Values

What does it mean to be well educated? Have family members create a list of words and actions that describe an educated person. (i.e. communicates clearly, reads well, is very good at a skill, can learn things on their own, is computer literate, completes high school, has been to college, models good manners, appreciates the arts).
