The Utah State School Board is seeking public comment on drafts of the state's English language arts new supplemental standards for Humanities and Professional and Technical Communication. Comments will be accepted through January 13, 2023. These standards supplement the <u>Utah Core</u> Standards for English Language Arts and have been created to provide Utah educators with guidance on the specific knowledge and skills for students to learn when enrolled in these two courses. JUUL Gets Schooled

Thank You! It was somewhat preposterous and audacious for the PTA Board to ask all school districts in Utah to consider joining a lawsuit against big tobacco. It would take lots of courage, foresight, and a deep understanding of the terrible consequences of youth vaping. But you did. Thank you! Utah will benefit most: There were about 1,400 school districts that signed up nationwide, but Utah had the highest participation rate in the USA, due in part to the support of Utah PTA. 36 of the 41 districts in Utah joined, which includes 98% of the students in public schools. The



next closest state was Idaho at 84%. JUUL settled all lawsuits against them for \$1.7 billion in December 2022. Around 1/3 of that amount is allocated for school districts. School districts will need to approve it by April 7, 2023 in order to participate. Joel Wright – Kirton/McConkie Law (For more information, see this **New York Times** article)
