
Register Now for National PTA Townhall

For the 2022-2023 school year, more than 460 schools across the state have participated in Reflections. The school level of Reflections is wrapping up and most school specialists are now taking a well deserved rest while they wait to see how entries from their school do at higher levels. However, there is one vital task that every PTA president needs to attend to--make sure your membership dues are paid and that your bylaws are current as of December 1st. If your bylaws are not current, entries from your school may not win at region, meaning they are ineligible to advance to the state level.
