Why does a PTA need technology?

- Family-school partnership is key to helping students reach their full potential. Partnership comes through the communication between parents, teachers, community, etc.
- Unfortunately, there are large communication gaps.
- Technology offers accessibility and bridges traditional gaps in communication.
- PTAs can bridge the gaps by being a strong link and resource for families and schools.

What can technology do for a PTA?

- Streamline PTA operations and connect with families.
- Empower a PTA to thrive and avoid PTA burnout.
- Become more efficient, organized, and visible.
- Enhance PTA abilities to support students and the school community.



Technology Costs

- Are PTAs allowed to spend PTA dollars on technology?
 - Yes! Your local PTA is a membership association & a nonprofit business.
 - PTAs can budget for & spend money on any technology that will be used by the PTA.
 - Purchased with PTA funds = PTA Ownership

Resource: techsoup

- A nonprofit organization that acts as a middleman between tech companies and nonprofits providing resources like:
 - Discounted or Donated Software and Hardware: Partners with major tech companies like Microsoft, Adobe, and Cisco to offer discounted or donated licenses for their software and hardware products.
 - Tech Resources and Community: Provides articles, tutorials, and webinars on using technology effectively and online forums where nonprofit staff can connect and ask questions.

 - A unit must be in good standing with to be approved by Utah PTA for some of these services.



- <u>Google Workspace for Nonprofit</u>
 - Google Workspace (formerly G Suite) is a suite of cloud computing, productivity and collaboration tools, software and products- like Drive, Gmail, Calendar, Docs, Sheets, Slides, Meet, Chat, Forms, Sites and more.
 - Keep PTA files, procedure books, and event schedules organized and accessible to all.

- Drive:
 - A secure and convenient way to store your files online and access them from anywhere. It also offers collaboration features that can be helpful for organizations like PTAs.
 - Digital Procedure Book
 - Create and share files/folders for each committee, event, etc.
 - Digital files to carry over from year to year for quick and easy access to previous years' efforts.





- Calendar:
 - Make and share a public or private calendar(s)
 - Schedule PTA meetings, school events, and spirit weeks
 - Send out automatic reminders to ensure everyone stays informed.
 - Color code events for school, PTA, events, etc.
 - Changes you make update everyone's calendar live.
 - Embedded on your webpage or linked to Facebook page.
 - Printable calendar version available





- Subscribing to a Google Calendar:
 - How to subscribe to a Google Calendar
 - Subscribe to the Utah PTA Calendar









- Docs, Sheets, and Slides:
 - Online software to create and edit documents directly in Drive/web browser. Eliminating the need to download a copy or use a traditional desktop.
 - \circ Real-time collaboration
 - Automatic saving, visible edits, and revision history.
 - Replaces Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
 - Files created in Microsoft can be converted to Google files to take advantage of editing capabilities.



- Virtual Meetings:
 - Provides more opportunities for connection and involvement.
 - An option for people to be involved and engaged who might not otherwise be able to because they live far away, have busy schedules, etc.

 - Track attendance and collect data.
 - Communicate updates.






- Design Tools:
