Checklist

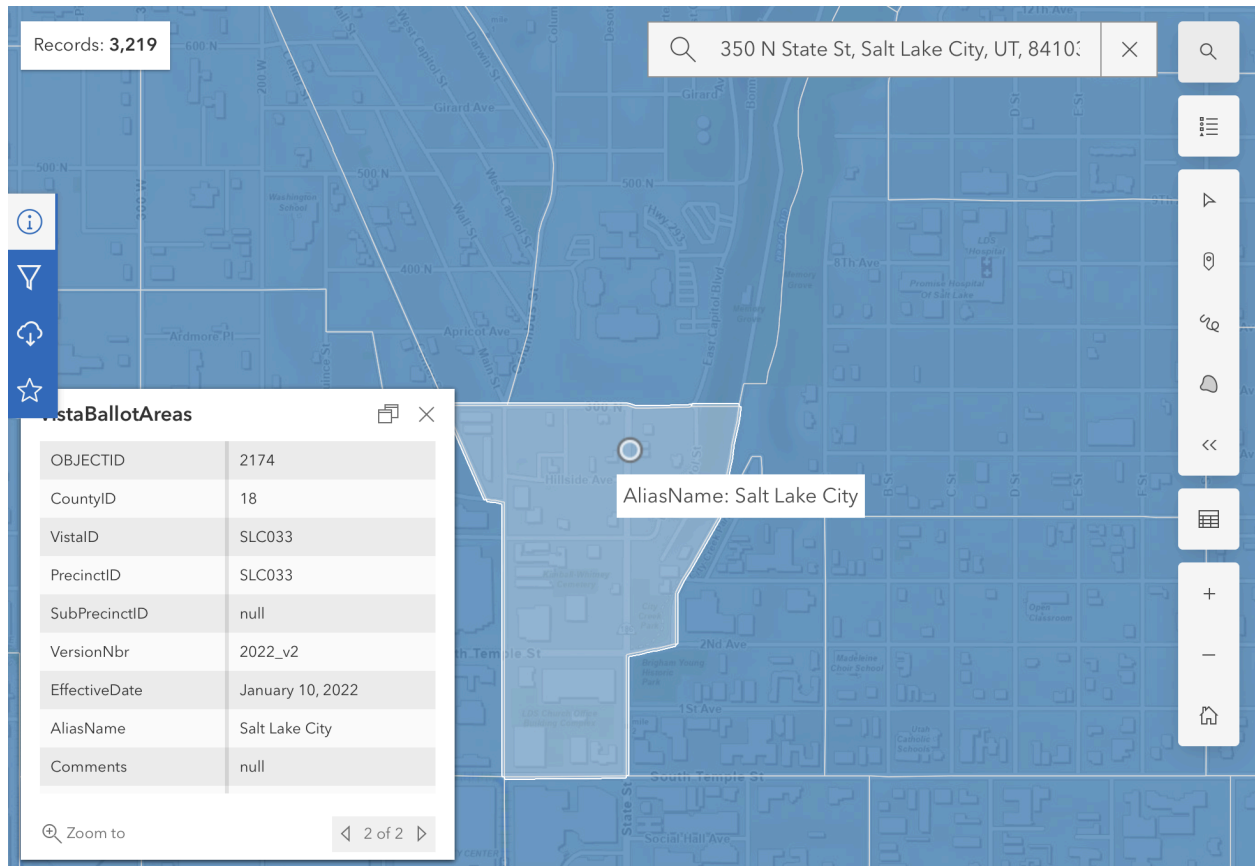
- ☐ Register with the party of your choice
- ☐ Find your voting precinct
- ☐ Find out your neighborhood caucus night
- ☐ Make arrangements to attend with your friends

1. Make sure you are registered as a voter in the party of your choice.

2. Find your [voting precinct](#)

- A precinct (your official neighborhood area)- how a city or town is divided for voting
- You can also see it listed under your [voter registration](#) on vote.utah.gov



3. Find when your neighborhood caucus night is for your political party, often announced in November or December

- Caucus night is usually the end of March on even years (2024, 2026, etc), usually close to the end of the Legislative Session.

4. Encourage supportive friends to attend your neighborhood caucus meeting and vote for advocates for children and public education.

- A suggested number of friends is 20.

5. Ask someone attending the caucus meeting to nominate you to be the state or county delegate.

- State delegates choose candidates for Congress, Governor and some other state offices.
- County delegates choose candidates for the Utah Legislature and county seats and offices.

6. Vote for child advocates and pro-public education delegates from your caucus and urge support of public schools in your communities.
