

Utah PTA Gold Star Region PTA Requirements

Complete all of the starred items under each of the 3 Utah PTA Vision areas and 3 of the unstarred items (from any heading) for a total of 15 completed items

Advocate:

- ___ * Attend all of your region and state board meetings or send an alternate
- ___ * Have a board member from your region attend Advocacy Conference or PTA Day at the Capitol
- ___ * Have a board member serve on a Utah PTA Commission and report back to the region
- ___ Have a board member attend at least 1 school board meeting each month and report back to region
- ___ Have a board member write an elected official about a PTA issue
- ___ Have a board member serve on a district level committee and report back to region

Develop:

- ___ * Complete region reports #1 & #2
- ___ * Have a nominating committee
- ___ * Facilitate the Utah PTA awards program for region and move winners onto state
- ___ * Do a needs assessment
- ___ * Host region PTA pre or post-convention training
- ___ Attend Utah PTA Leadership Convention and complete assigned tasks
- ___ Create or update standing rules for region

Engage:

- ___ * Promote membership growth
- ___ * Promote the Reflections program
- ___ * Visit at least ¼ of your council PTAs once throughout the year
- ___ * Hold regular region meetings/trainings
- ___ Hold a region level, parent information night
- ___ Host an extra training deemed needed in your region
- ___ Create or use an existing way to communicate with local leaders in your region. Example: FB page, group text, newsletter, Instagram, etc. Have at least 4 communications go out with this new or existing form of communication
