

Proposed Utah PTA Bylaw Amendments – December 2025

The bylaws committee moves the following changes to the Utah PTA Bylaws:

Article X: Officers, Directors, Commissioners, and Representatives

<p>Current Language:</p> <p>Section 2. The directors of Utah PTA shall be the director of communications, the director of leadership, the director of membership, and the area directors.</p> <p>a. These directors shall be elected from the membership of Utah PTA at large.</p> <p>b. The term of each director shall be two (2) years or until their successor is elected.</p> <p>c. Each director shall serve no more than three (3) consecutive terms.</p> <p>d. These directors shall manage the operations of their specific position as assigned by the Utah PTA Board of Directors</p> <p>Section 5. The officers, directors, commissioners, and representatives shall, for purposes of election and tenure, be divided into two (2) groups, designated as Group One and Group Two.</p> <p>a. Group One shall be elected in odd-numbered years and shall consist of: the president-elect, advocacy vice president, secretary, director of leadership, director of membership, education commissioner, safety commissioner, area directors of odd-numbered areas, and administrator representative.</p> <p>b. Group Two shall be elected in even-numbered years and shall consist of: the area vice president, compliance vice president, treasurer, director of communications, area directors from even-numbered areas, community engagement commissioner, family life commissioner, health commissioner, and teacher representative.</p>	<p>New Language:</p> <p>Section 2. The directors of Utah PTA shall be the director of communications, the director of leadership, the director of membership, <u>the director of programs</u>, and the area directors.</p> <p>a. These directors shall be elected from the membership of Utah PTA at large.</p> <p>b. The term of each director shall be two (2) years or until their successor is elected.</p> <p>c. Each director shall serve no more than three (3) consecutive terms.</p> <p>d. These directors shall manage the operations of their specific position as assigned by the Utah PTA Board of Directors</p> <p>Section 5. The officers, directors, commissioners, and representatives shall, for purposes of election and tenure, be divided into two (2) groups, designated as Group One and Group Two.</p> <p>a. Group One shall be elected in odd-numbered years and shall consist of: the president-elect, advocacy vice president, secretary, director of leadership, director of membership, education commissioner, safety commissioner, area directors of odd-numbered areas, and administrator representative.</p> <p>b. Group Two shall be elected in even-numbered years and shall consist of: the area vice president, compliance vice president, treasurer, director of communications, <u>director of programs</u>, area directors from even-numbered areas, community engagement commissioner, family life commissioner, health commissioner, and teacher representative.</p>
<p>Rationale: As directed by the Board of Directors, this adds the Programs Director as a member of the Board of Directors. This allows for better planning, collaboration, and programming within Utah PTA.</p>
